## AGE GROUPS

Day Camp allows children 6-12 years old to experience a wide variety of activities and adventures. All campers must have completed at least one year of school (does not include pre-school programs).

Groups are traditionally formed by age, keeping campers who are similar ages and grades together. Groups are co-ed and have at least two counselors. The size depends on the week and enrollment, with the average size around 20 campers. If you have a request to be with a friend please let camp know before the session begins. # TEEN LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

Our three-week long Teen Leadership Program is for campers 13-15 year olds, who want to learn leadership skills while at camp. During the first week teens are traditional campers. The second week focuses on giving back to camp and the community by working on service projects. Teens work with a specific day camp group during the third week, develop a relationship with younger campers, and imagine themselves in a counselor position.
